Finally the news we have been waiting for. The tension growing between the Lascivii and Savage Intent has come to a head with a large scale attack by the Lascivii against their former village, Varak.

Around 7000 troops of mixed types, both mounted and on foot marched to Varak accompanied by no less than 12 ballista, a siege ram and a siege tower. In the end none of the siege engines were deployed as the battle was fought in the open, the fort was deemed too small for the defending forces. Ranged against them in the defence of Varak were the 8000 men of the Savage Intent Army of the West. This army although bigger had a higher level of militia and light forces. This proved to be fatal in the later stages of the battle with the heavier Cascivii units carving their way through the Savage Intent lines and routing key units. Even the Savage Intent light cavalry with their numeric superiority were defeated by the Cascivii militia cavalry and archers turning the battle into a rout from which there was no recovery. Cosses to both forces were very heavy but Varak has a new flag flying above the buildings.
